 - Markers and pencils
 - Compound Words Assessment–Individual Record form
 - Compound Words Assessment–Class Record form
- Why Use ItThis assessment helps you learn whether children can read simple compound words and
identify the component parts.
- **How to Use It** > Administer this assessment individually.
 - Have the child read the words on the Compound Words list. If the child finds a word difficult, prompt her once to look for a part she knows. On another copy of the form, note accurate responses and errors and score the number read correctly. Then ask the child to make a slash between the two component words.
- What to Notice \triangleright Number of compound words the child recognises
 - Specific compound words the child recognises
 - Specific compound words the child can take apart
